Tasting Notes -

Our 2009 Estate Grown Merlot is a rich, well balanced wine. The aromas are full of berry fruits with nicely integrated lightly toasted oak aromas. The palate is very expressive and is displaying a wonderful balance. The roundness of the Merlot is balanced by its own acidity and also the nicely integrated tannin structure of the Cabernet Franc. The finish is long and full. Drink Now Through 2021.

VINEYARDS, VINTAGE AND VINIFICATION -

Home Ranch Vineyard Oak Knoll District, Napa Valley
Knollwood Vineyard Oak Knoll District, Napa Valley
Vineyard Soils Pleasanton & Yolo Series Loam

Our Merlot vineyards are planted to Clones #181 and #314 on #3309 and #420A rootstock. The grapes are lush and power packed with intense berry flavors and an abundance of bright fruit.

The 2009 Merlot continues a long tradition of well-balanced wines for us with this varietal. One of the great aspects of growing this varietal in our Oak Knoll District region is that we can fully ripen the fruit while still maintaining ample acidity in the grapes at harvest. This is due to our unique location from which we can benefit from the warmth of the southern alley but also the cool bay breezes each afternoon.
