TASTING NOTES

The 2010 Yewell Cabernet Sauvignon is displaying the most refined tannins of our Vineyard Designate series. This is typical of this vineyard. I find nice ample red berry aromas that are wonderfully supported by a rich layer of toasty oak. The texture of the wine is wonderful and seamless, and the deep berry fruit comes through all across the palate. The finish is rich and lingering.

VINEYARDS, VINTAGE AND VINIFICATION

Cabernet Sauvignon Yewell Vineyard, Clone 337
St. Helena, Napa Valley (100%)

A great satisfaction in producing our Vineyard Designate series of Cabernet Sauvignon is the selection of the wine to be used. Since 1982, we have farmed Cabernet Sauvignon from the Yewell Vineyard in the St. Helena appellation of Napa Valley. We produced only 6 barrels from the 2010 vintage.

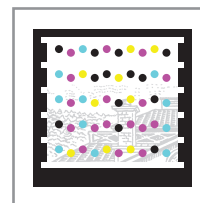

St. Helena Sub-Appellation

Climate: Warm, due to greater protection from western hills, with less fog or wind incursions. The narrowing of the valley floor provides more heat reflection off the hillsides. Mid-summer temperature peak is often in the mid- to high 90°F range (31 to 35°C).

Soils: Principally gravelly silt loams, sedimentary in origin, and gravelly alluvial soils with rock.

Principal Characteristics: ripe, violet aromas and rich, but supple flavors and firm tannins.
