TASTING NOTES

Winemaker, Chris Corley We have grown accustomed to the deeply pigmented wines from the small berries at this vineyard site. The intensity of the color is an inviting indication of the powerful wine to follow. One discovers a profound attack on the palate, exerting a strong full-bodied presence right from the beginning. The flavors display ample dark black fruits framed by powerful tannins as the wine crosses the palate and segues confidently to a long and lingering finish. Decant 30-60 Minutes Prior to Serving. Drink Now through 2028.

VINEYARDS, VINTAGE AND VINIFICATION

Our Yountville Single Vineyard was harvested on three separate days between October 20 and November 2, 2011. This was one of the latest harvest dates for this vineyard largely due to the cool, longer growing season. We were able to let the fruit hang in the vineyard for an extended time in 2011, allowing the grapes to develop full ripeness on the vine without an accompanying high level of sugar accumulation. The fruit was hand-picked and meticulously sorted upon arrival at the winery. Our goal with this wine and the others in our Vineyard Designate Series is to present as pure an expression as possible from each given vineyard site. Alcohol 14.1 %
